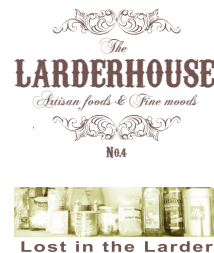

Competition details / rules:

- All applications must be received by the 8th of September 2011.
- All competitors must belong to or represent a catering establishment (restaurant, bar, pub, café etc) which is currently trading in Dorset.
- Only one cheeseboard can be submitted per establishment.
- The competitor must provide all equipment and ingredients needed.
- The cheeseboard should be designed as a serving for two people.
- Competitors will be given an allocated time of ten minutes to showcase their cheeseboard to the judging panel. It is split into two 5 minute sections, the 'Offering' and the 'Tasting'. Firstly, the competitor must explain what they are offering along with knowledge and reasoning behind the selection. This is followed by a 5 minute tasting and questions from the judges towards the competitor.
- Competitors may bring along someone to perform the 'Offering'. This could be, for example, a front of house member that is confident in explaining what the Chef is offering.
- In this years competition we are also asking you to present a drink accompaniment to your cheese board. This pairing should also be explained during the "offering".
- The competition takes place in the Scout Hall at the Sturminster Newton Cheese Festival on Sunday 11th of September 2011. All competitors need to register at the scout hall 1 hour before their allocated presentation time. Please visit <http://www.cheesefestival.co.uk> for directions.
- The judging will follow set criteria covering elements such as appearance, locality of cheeses, knowledge of the board, accompaniments, size, creativity etc. Each board will be awarded a score and the highest score will win 'Dorset's Best Cheese Board 2011'
- The judging panel may request to see a final selection of competitors prior to the results.
- The winning cheeseboard must be featured on the winning establishments menu for a period of one year (starting no later than October 1st 2011).
- The winning competitor will receive a plaque with 'Dorset's Best Cheese Board 2011 Winner' for display in their establishment.
